



ENJOY the counties of Skåne, Halland, Blekinge and Kronoberg



SKÅNE – a coastal jewel and the southernmost province of Sweden. Captivating nature, gastronomy and lots of music and culture to experience. In the east you find Kristianstad's wetlands, the oldest biosphere reserve in the country and protected by UNESCO, and the picturesque Österlen, the "Provence of Sweden". Skåne offers 1 250 km of walking trails as well as cycle paths gilded by 573 km of coastal line. Here you find Sweden's third biggest city, Malmö, with the Öresund bridge to Copenhagen. Innovative architecture and friendly atmosphere await you.

HALLAND – a marvellous coastal landscape with endless sandy beaches, of which Mellbystrand, Tylösand and Skrea are some. Not without reason called "Little Italy". The interior of the province has also much to offer such as food like game and plenty of mushrooms. The province animal is the salmon and the seat of the county government is Halmstad. This region is also famous for its great golf courses.

BLEKINGE – has a wonderful archipelago, with an unusually high biodiversity, along its entire coastal line. It has the highest number of lakes - often with small islands and skerries - per square kilometre in Sweden. This small province has also a rich cultural history. Karlskrona, which is a world heritage with its rich maritime history, is also the seat of the county government. A visit to the Maritime museum is "a must". The province animal is the stag-beetle.

KRONOBERG – known for its glass, furniture, design, forests, lakes and entrepreneurship. This is where IKEA was founded by Ingvar Kamprad. A famous Swedish writer, Vilhelm Moberg, was born here and so was the botanist Carl von Linné (Carl Linnaeus). Musical and cultural life here is rich. The province is also known for its diversity of good food. The seat of the county government, Växjö has a restaurant - PM & Vänner - that has been awarded a Michelin star.
